Paul's Main Message in this Letter?

Actively Follow the Example of Jesus!!

Chapter 1, Verse 27: "Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the Gospel of Christ . . ."

Two Examples (Living out the Example of Christ)

Timothy (Chapter 2, Starting in Verse 19)

"Faithfully serves in the Gospel of Christ"

Epaphroditus (Chapter 2, Verse 29 & 30)

"So then, welcome him in the Lord with great joy, and honor people like him. Because he almost died for the work of Christ . . ."

Be Living Expressions of Jesus with your Mind & Thoughts!

Trouble Areas in Philippi (Mind/Thoughts):

Conflict – Euodia & Syntyche (Chapter 4, Verse 2)

"I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord."

Anxiety of the Believers (Chapter 4, Verse 6 & 7)

"Do not be <u>anxious</u> about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your request to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, <u>will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus</u>."

What are we to think on?

Chapter 4, Verse 8: "Finally brothers and sisters, whatever is <u>true</u>, whatever is <u>noble</u>, whatever is <u>right</u>, whatever is <u>pure</u>, whatever is <u>lovely</u>, whatever is <u>admirable</u> - - if anything is <u>excellent or praiseworthy</u> - - think about such things."
